The clients wished to create a modern and desert-appropriate home, which provided both a visual and physical connection to the four-acre desert site situated to avoid undesirable solar heat gain. A compact floor plan of 2,300 square feet was arranged around a series of three steel-clad "boxes" connected by a seemingly floating roof. Floor-toceiling glass walls blur the lines between interior and exterior spaces. Patios function as exterior living rooms utilizing the panoramic desert views.
